**Subject:** LDF Exhibition  
Dear Ian

I have been asked by local residents to write to you and express their dissatisfaction that the recent LDF exhibitions did not include any venues in the Five Villages.

Given that the combined population of the Five Villages is greater than that of Arundel and that 5 out of the 8 locations under consideration for strategic development are in or around the Five Villages, this seems unbalanced and the consultation may well lean even further towards the views of the urban areas as a result.

In Aldingbourne, the Parish Council felt there was a need to address this imbalance and called a public meeting to do this.

As you know Arun provided the exhibition for 5 days each in Bognor, Littlehampton and Arundel - 15 days in total.

I believe it would make better sense for future consultations to include the Five Villages (and possibly Angmering too). Perhaps 3 days in each of the three urban centres would be enough. This would then leave 6 days which could be shared throughout the Five Villages and other areas - no extra resources would be needed!

Could you please let me know your views on this.
