Dear Councillor Bower

As you will be aware there is increasing disquiet at the manner in which Arun's LDF has been conducted. We are concerned that the LDF process, so far, falls well below the expectations outlined in the Council's Statement of Community Involvement.

We outlined a number of concerns in our recent response to the Core Strategy Options for Growth consultation. We are aware that others have also expressed dissatisfaction – including concerns relating to your own conduct.

The concerns expressed by ourselves and other members of the public were not brought to the attention of Councillors at meetings of the LDF Sub-Committee held since the LDF Core Strategy Options for Growth consultation.

Can you please advise how the Council and its LDF Sub-Committee intend to respond to the concerns that have been raised by the public?
